

Data Act compliance checks

a. Introductory text

The **Data Act**, which enters into effect on 12 September 2025, introduces new rules for sharing, using, and making data available within the EU. Whether you create data through IoT devices, software, or industrial platforms, there's a strong chance you may (partly) fall under this regulation. A quick check can help you avoid acting too late, missing business opportunities, or facing penalties.

b. Checklist: are you in scope?

Answer "yes" or "no":

- ▶ Do you make or sell connected devices, IoT products, or apps that collect data?
- Do you provide cloud services or data processing to other businesses?
- ▶ Do your products or services automatically generate usage or performance data?
- ls it currently **NOT** easy for your customer or user to get their own data in a usable format?
- Do you have significant control over data access in your market or industry?
